God the Holy Spirit: His Person and Work

- 1. The Trinity
 - a. One God existing eternally in three Persons: Father, Son, and Spirit
 - b. Each Person possesses the fullness of the divine nature and essence
 - c. Deity of the Father, uncontested
 - d. Deity of the Son, see my paper, "Jesus Christ is God"
 - e. Proof texts: Matthew 28:19; 2 Corinthians 13:14; 1 Peter 1:1-2
- 2. The Holy Spirit is a Person, not a "force"
 - a. He teaches (Luke 12:11-12)
 - b. He speaks and calls (Acts 13:2)
 - c. He can be grieved (Ephesians 4:30)
- 3. The Holy Spirit is a Divine Person
 - a. He is omnipresent (Psalm 139:7)
 - b. Lying to the Holy Spirit is Lying to God (Acts 5:3-4)
 - c. He is omniscient (1 Corinthians 2:10-11)
 - d. He lives in God's temple (1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19)
 - e. He is eternal (Hebrews 9:14)
- 4. The Holy Spirit in the Scriptures
 - a. Active in creation (Genesis 1:2)
 - b. In the OT, He would come upon people, often to inspire them to prophesy (1 Samuel 10:10, 16:13) and could depart from them (Psalm 51:11)
 - c. Active in Scripture inspiration (2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:21)
 - d. Key Passages in the Gospel of John (14:16-26, 16:7-14)
 - i. Guides believers into truth (understanding and application)
 - ii. Points not to Himself, but to the Son in order to glorify Him
 - iii. Convicts of sin, righteousness, and judgment
- 5. Coming of the Holy Spirit in the Book of Acts (Acts 1:8)
 - a. In three installments, beginning in Acts 2:2-4, Cf. Acts 8:4-6, 10:44-46
 - i. Attested to by signs, to convince unbelievers, temporary sign gifts
 - ii. Hebrews 2:3-4; 1 Corinthians 14:21-22, 13:8-10
- 6. Other Ministries of God the Holy Spirit
 - a. Aid God's people in prayers (Romans 8:26-27)
 - b. Empower believers for spiritual service (1 Corinthians 12:7)
 - c. Seal Christians, securing their eternal salvation (Ephesians 1:13-14)
 - d. Continually sanctify believers (Ephesians 5:18, literally in the Greek—"keep on being filled with the Spirit")
