Context: Psalm 78, "A Contemplation of Asaph"

Themes: God's kindness to, redemptive work for, and faithfulness towards Israel

Scope: Primarily Exodus, Also Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua, Judges, 1 Samuel and 2 Samuel

<u>Christological Significance:</u> Christ Jesus fulfills all the themes above in the spiritual sense.

<u>Summary Statement:</u> God has proven His faithfulness in history, and can be trusted now, to fulfill His purposes in you.

 - c. Refusal to Live in Christ's Freedom: John 8:32-36
 - d. Return to Sin's Bondage: Galatians 4:9
