Peter	Simon, Cephas	Apostle to the Jews, Leader and spokesman of the band of disciples, wrote 1&2 Peter
Andrew		Peter's brother, Fisherman by trade, a skilled fisher of men
James	Son of Zebedee	First martyr of the faith
John	Son of Zebedee	Apostle of Love, wrote the Gospel of John, 1&2&3 John, and Revelation
Philip		Analytical thinker, leader of the second "group of four" disciples
Bartholomew	Nathaniel	Sincere and spiritually perceptive
Thomas	Didymus (Twin)	Zealous for the cause of Christ, but best known for doubting Jesus' Resurrection
Matthew	Levi	Tax Collector and sinner turned saint, wrote the Gospel of Matthew
James the Son of Alphaeus		Leader of the third "group of four" disciples
Lebbaeus	Thaddeus, Judas	Little known, faithful disciple
Simon the Cananite	Simon the Zealot	Member of revolutionary party that sought to overthrow Rome
Judas Iscariot		Only disciple from Judea, treasurer of the group, a thief, the betrayer of the Lord Jesus

Matthias	Justus	In Acts 1:26, he was chosen to replace Judas Iscariot
Paul	Saul	Converted after persecuting Christians, an Apostle chosen later (1 Corinthians 15:8-10)
