'The Days After Christmas', (Luke 2:17,20, NKJV)

"Now when they had seen Him, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child... Then the shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things that they had heard and seen, as it was told them" (Luke 2:17,20)

The first Christmas had come and gone. Little Lord Jesus laid asleep on the hay. Mary was tired, even as she pondered the greatness of the Child that God had used her to bring into the world.
